

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## UK Parliamentary election for the Hereford & South Herefordshire Constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve Hereford & South Herefordshire.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the offices of the Acting Returning Officer, Electoral Services Office, Blueschool House, Blueschool Street, Hereford, HR1 2LX during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Electoral Services Office, Blueschool House, Blueschool Street, Hereford, HR1 2LX between the hours of 10am and 4pm on any working day after the date of this notice (excluding bank holidays) but no later than **4pm on Friday, 7th June 2024**.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as banker in the United Kingdom.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 4th July 2024**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday, 18th June 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Electoral Services Office, Blueschool House, Blueschool Street, Hereford, HR1 2LX by **5pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024**. 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on **Wednesday, 26th June 2024**.
